(Dry, a fine Georgian wine that matures for 9 months in oak casks. The wine made from Saperavi grapes and shows aromas of black current, dark chocolate with a sprinkling of vanilla and spice. 13.5% alc., 5 oz.)

Saperavi

(Dry, imported from the Republic of Georgia, medium-bodied dry red wine, 100% Saperavi grapes with a distinguishable aroma of wild berries and extraordinary bouquet with a slight spicy edge, 13.5% alc., 5 oz.)

Pomegranate Wine

(Semi-Sweet, imported from Armenia and fermented from 100% pure pomegranate juice, 12% alc., 5 oz.)

Akhasheni

(Semi-Sweet, imported from Georgia, fermented with fresh notes of blackberries, cherry and licorice, the wine of intense dark, garnet color has a well-balanced bouquet with pleasant softness in taste, 11% alc., 5 oz.)

Pinot Grigio

Tsinandali

(Semi-Dry, imported from Europe, its flavors are soft and smooth, not overly fat or buttery, a fruity wine with forward tones of lemon and ripe melon, has a light body leading to a medium vanilla finish, 12% alc., 4 oz.)

Tvishi

(Semi-Sweet, imported from the Republic of Georgia, made of Tsolikauri grape variety, cultivated in Tsageri on the beautiful mountainous terrain.. The wine is light-straw in color, has a varietal bouquet with flower tones in aroma and a harmonious piquant taste that brings a long, pleasant after-taste with a delicate tint of honey, 10.5% alc., 4 oz.)
